About Woodgate.

Woodgate is located in the Wide Bay area about 30 minutes south of Bundaberg.

From Brisbane it is an approx. 4 hour drive and similar from Rockhampton.

The section of beach most suitable for blokarting is near the beach access off Walkers Point Rd just south of Woodgate.

There are no toilets at this location. However there are toilets in Banksia Park which is about 800m along the beach back towards Woodgate.

The beach near the 4WD access point and further south east is wide and hard. The beach narrows as you head north west along the beach towards the main township of Woodgate. 4WD vehicles can park on the beach while for everyone else there is some parking available near the top of the beach access.

The best winds for blokarting is a north easterly breeze.

The NRMA caravan park is approx. 2 km from the 4wd beach access point on the esplanade. The caravan park has a range of facilities including a

convenience store, camp kitchen, laundry facilities, two amenities blocks and a cafe serving breakfast and lunch.

Catering.

The club is not planning on doing any sausage sizzle lunches. So plan ahead to self-cater. There is a general store and a friendly grocer store and some cafes and takeaway shops as well as a bowls club and a pub that both do meals.

A group booking for dinner on the Saturday night will be arranged if there is enough interest.
