

**‘2022 Woodgate Classic’
October 21st to 23rd
Woodgate Beach, Queensland.**

NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is the Capricornia Blokart Club Inc.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be conducted under the IBRA Racing Rules version 8, including any current IBRA clarifications.
- 1.2 The Green Fleet Racing rules (Appendix 2) will be used for the green fleet activities.
- 1.3 These documents can be easily downloaded from <http://www.australianblokartassociation.org/Rules-and-Tips.php>

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All competitors must be financial members of an IBRA recognised body through either direct memberships or through a member club. Evidence of membership may be required to be produced.
- 2.2 By completing and lodging the entry form the entrant undertakes to abide by the IBRA Racing Rules and the values of sportsmanship.
- 2.3 Entries for the Marathon will be accepted in the following:
Full Marathon (2 Hours)
Half Marathon (1 Hour) Recommended for Inexperienced and Novice Blokart Sailors; or competitors not wishing to compete in the full marathon.
- 2.4 Entries for the Short Course regatta will be accepted in the following groups:
Performance
Production
Novice/Green Fleet
You may only enter one group.

3. Entry Form and Fees

3.1 Entrants shall use the on line Entry Form or the printable entry form in Appendix 1.

3.2 The entry fee shall be as per the table below.

Woodgate Classic Regatta Entry Fee paid before 1st October 2022. The entry fee includes entry to the short course events as well as either the Full or Half marathon. Transponder hire fee is included.	\$50.00
Late ENTRY Fee This is in addition to the entry fee.	\$20.00

3.4 Entries received after 1st October will incur a late fee of \$20.

3.5 No Entries will be received after 1800hrs on Friday 21st October 2022.

3.6 Scoring transponders will be used. The transponder hire is included in the entry fees. Failure to return the transponder at the end of the regatta shall incur a \$200 fee.

Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Race Noticeboard and communicated at an Information session.

6. Onsite/Online Race Noticeboard

6.1 The Official Race Notice Board shall be located at online at

www.sandyachting.info and if needed posted to a noticeboard on the beach near the timing marque.

7. Course description

- 7.1 Races will be sailed in the area on Woodgate beach between Banksia Park and Burrum Point. (Appendix 3)
- 7.2 The Half Marathon will be sailed on a course that has legs of approx. 1 kilometre in length.
- 7.3 The Full Marathon will be sailed on a course that has legs of approx. 3 - 5 kilometre in length.
- 7.4 The short course regatta will be sailed on a course with an upwind leg of approx. 500metres.
- 7.5 The track surface is sand.
- 7.6 Access to the racing area is via pathways near Banksia Park or via the 4 wheel drive access point off Walkers Point Rd.
Vehicles parked on the beach must be parked south of the 4WD access road. The short course racing area and the marathon start/finish area will be approximately 200m South from the pathways near Banksia Park.
- 7.7 The Half Marathon race duration is 60 minutes.
- 7.8 The Full Marathon race duration is 120 minutes.
- 7.9 The short course regatta will consist of multiple races, with a race duration of 8 minutes.

8. Information session and oral instructions

- 8.1 Mandatory information sessions will be held before racing each day for all entrants on Woodgate beach near the start/finish line as per the times below.
Short Course Regatta Competitors 0945hrs on 22nd October.
Half Marathon competitors 0945hrs on 23rd October.
Full Marathon competitors 1115hrs on 23rd October.
- 8.2 Further information sessions may be held as required.

9. Scoring

For the Short Course regatta, a minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a series, and scoring will be in accordance

with IBRA Rule Book Edition 8, Part H (Scoring), H2

The Half and Full marathons will be scored separate to the short course regatta. Scoring will be in accordance with IBRA Rule Book Edition 8, Part H (Scoring), H2

10. Prizes

10.1 Short Course regatta

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each division that has 5 or more entries.

For divisions with less than five entries only 1st place will be awarded.

Other place getters and/or spot prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the event organisers.

10.2 Marathons.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each division that has 5 or more entries.

For divisions with less than five entries only 1st place will be awarded.

Other place getters and/or spot prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the event organisers.

11. Advertising

Entrant's blokarts may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority, and to be available for photo opportunities with local politicians.

12. Insurance

Only Third Party insurance is provided for racing following nomination acceptance, however, deliberately negligent or reckless behaviour will nullify any claim.

Personal insurance is not provided for any entrant and should this be required, separate private arrangements should be made.

Further information

1. Venue

The regatta will be held on Woodgate Beach, Queensland.

Woodgate Beach is approximately 50km South of Bundaberg.

The race area will be on Woodgate beach starting near Banksia Park at the northern end and extending along the beach towards Burrum Point.

Woodgate Classic 2022 NOR.

We suggest competitors stay at the NRMA Woodgate Beach Holiday Park. They have a range of cabins, caravan sites and camping sites. They are located on the beach front at Woodgate.

Banksia Park is approx. 2km from the caravan park.
